Dermal Filler Level 2: Advanced Techniques in Facial Rejuvenation and Myomodulation

Learning Objectives

By the end of this course, participants will be able to:

- Analyze facial aging patterns with emphasis on mid-face and lower-face changes.
- Apply advanced anatomy knowledge through mapping, evaluation, and treatment planning of the mid-face and lips.
- Demonstrate expert injection techniques for mid-cheek enhancement, volume restoration, and smoothing in younger and older patients.
- Perform precision lip augmentation, including vermilion border, cupid's bow, and philtrum enhancement, using backfilling and swelling management strategies.
- Understand the role of myomodulation and how fillers can restore natural, youthful facial movement.
- Explore the use of solid fillers and collagen bio-stimulators, including patient selection criteria.
- Safely dissolve filler with hyaluronidase and manage re-filling strategies after correction.
- Identify and manage advanced complications such as vascular occlusion and compression injuries.

Course Description

This advanced training builds upon foundational skills and provides participants with the expertise to perform high-level facial rejuvenation using dermal fillers. Participants will prepare with on-demand online modules covering advanced anatomy, facial aging, filler science, ultrasound mapping, and step-by-step treatment demonstrations for mid-face, cheek, lip, and lower-face rejuvenation.

The live course emphasizes individualized assessment and advanced injection strategies. Under expert supervision, attendees will practice on their own pre-consented patients or on course-provided volunteers. Techniques include mid-cheek volumization, precision lip enhancement, vermilion border definition, and philtrum shaping, as well as safe management of swelling and correction of unsatisfactory results with hyaluronidase.

By integrating advanced anatomical knowledge with hands-on patient training, this course equips participants to deliver natural, precise, and safe outcomes. Graduates of Level 2 training will be prepared to confidently expand their clinical repertoire and elevate their aesthetic practice.
